KUEHNER FOUNDERS' DAY SEMINAR



In celebration of Founders' Day the Faculty and Board of Directors of RES will host the annual Kuehner Seminar Lecture at St. Paul's Reformed Episcopal Church, 800 Church Road, Oreland, PA on Friday, December 2, 2011. The meeting begins with the Service of Holy Communion at 10:00 AM. The guest speaker is the Rev. Canon Daryl Fenton. The Rev. Mr. Fenton previously served as Canon for the Provincial and Global Mission of the Anglican Church in North

America and Canon to Archbishop Robert Duncan. He currently serves as the National Director of CMJ International, an Anglican Mission Society to the Jews founded in London in 1809. Canon Fenton will speak on the unique opportunity for Anglicans to reach America's Jewish people with the Gospel as well as the challenges of the 21st century as it relates to Anglican mission revival.
