

Reformed Episcopal Seminary's Net Price Template

Below is a detailed breakdown of the seminary's estimated costs for the 2021-2022 academic year. You can use this data to estimate how much you might expect to pay in total during one academic year of study. The only numbers that are set by the seminary are tuition, fees, and the rental cost of on-campus housing, so your actual costs for textbooks, rent, utilities, board, transportation, and other miscellaneous costs may vary from what is estimated below.

One additional consideration not represented here: most of our full-time students receive some form of tuition scholarship (e.g. 1/3 or 2/3), so actual tuition costs may be lower than what is listed in the tables below. The seminary also participates in the federal student aid program to offer direct federal loans to help further offset the costs of studying with us.
